
# **Respecting Country Parade 2025**

## PARADE ORDER:

- The parade will have two main sections:
  - South Australia's Migrant and Refugee Story and Our Ancestral Story of our Cultural Heritage
    - This section will made up of the many migrant and refugee communities of South Australia:



- South Australians at their Best
  - This section will be made up of broad range of South Australian communities:



#### FORMATION:

- We encourage you to be creative with your parade formations however;
- If unsure on parade formation, we recommend row formations (rows of 2) to give the parade a unified look.
- Coordinated dancing, walking, waving, enthusiastic movements and instrument-playing is encouraged.

COSTUMES/NATIONAL DRESS/UNIFORMS:

- Dress up and have fun!
- Traditional costumes, decorations, activities, and all other conduct of participants within the event must reflect that of your group's own cultural heritage and identity.

MUSIC:

- Background soundtrack on your own device (must be transportable, able to be carried
- etc...) or performed music with handheld acoustic and percussion instruments only. MOVEMENTS:
  - Parking: Adelaide Oval (Details TBC on/before Parade Rehearsal 14<sup>th</sup> Jan)
  - Arrival as a Group:

  - Drop-off area available for large parade materials eg:
    - Drums, large costumes, musical instruments
      - Drop-off area is <u>not</u> for general parade participants
- Registration Desk:
  - $\circ~$  Group Leaders sign-in at desk outside Adelaide Oval at Southern Gate near War Memorial Drive
  - $\circ~$  Please note once your group has registered, do not exit the Adelaide Oval due to safety/security.
- Parade Order: Follow Parade Marshalls and Volunteers to be taken to parade positioning inside Adelaide Oval
  - o Toilets available in Adelaide Oval
  - Undercover seating available
  - Ensure the safety, wellbeing, monitoring, and duty of care for all members of your group, particularly minors, throughout the event.
  - Wristbands will be available for use re: child protection.
- Parade Begins (Have fun!)
  - Audiences, families of parade participants and the public are encouraged to view the parade from the footbridge for the best view and experience.
- Finish in Elder Park

DISRUPTIVE CONDUCT:

- The Respecting Country Parade 2025 is <u>not</u> an opportunity to make political statements. Organisations or individuals must not promote political advocacy that is not consistent with intercultural and social cohesion.
- Compliance Officers will form a part of the Respecting Country Parade 2025's operations to ensure that community participants are protected in a safe way for all to enjoy the event.

- The Tour Down Under is a cycling race in and around Adelaide, South Australia. It is traditionally the opening event of the UCI World Tour and UCI Women's WorldTour.
